(V) A BNR LICENSE IS RESTRICTED TO THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE LICENSED PREMISES ONLY AND PROVIDES NO OFF-SALE PRIVILEGES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.
