

(C) AN EMPLOYEE WHO TRANSFERS INTO THE STATE CLASSIFIED OR UNCLASSIFIED SERVICE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL:

(1) BE GIVEN CREDIT FOR THE EMPLOYEE'S YEARS OF SERVICE RENDERED AS A STATE CONTRACTUAL EMPLOYEE FOR THE PURPOSES OF ESTABLISHING:

~~{1}--COMPENSATION--RATES,--INCLUDING---LONGEVITY STEPS;~~

(I) LONGEVITY STEPS IN THE PAY GRADE APPLICABLE TO THE JOB CLASSIFICATION OF THE BUDGETED POSITION INTO WHICH THE EMPLOYEE TRANSFERS;

(II) ANNUAL LEAVE; AND

(III) SENORITY RIGHTS; AND

(2) UPON INCLUSION BECOME A MEMBER OF THE STATE PENSION SYSTEM FOR RETIREMENT PURPOSES.

(D) (1) CONTRACTUAL STATE EMPLOYEES WHO HAVE LESS THAN 24 MONTHS OF SATISFACTORY CONTINUOUS SERVICE AS OF THE DATE OF REPLACEMENT, HAVE NO RIGHT TO EMPLOYMENT IN THE STATE CLASSIFIED OR UNCLASSIFIED SERVICE.

(2) IN ORDER TO ENABLE A CONTRACTUAL EMPLOYEE TO PARTICIPATE IN A COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION FOR A BUDGETED POSITION, THE SECRETARY OF PERSONNEL MAY AUTHORIZE CERTIFY THE CONTINUATION OF A CONTRACTUAL EMPLOYMENT RELATIONSHIP FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR.

(E) THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO PRECLUDE THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FROM PROHIBITING THE CREATION OF A BUDGETED POSITION OR THE REPLACEMENT OF A CONTRACTUAL POSITION WITH A BUDGETED POSITION IN THE ANNUAL STATE BUDGET.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.

(House Bill 1671)

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - Baltimore County - "Hannah More" Property
