CHAPTER 499

(Senate Bill 486)

AN ACT concerning

Racing - Half-Mile Days

FOR the purpose of changing-the-licensees-authorized-to-conduct half-mile-horse-racing-in-the-State-and-the--conditions--for tieensing; transferring certain days of half-mile racing from the Timonium track to the mile tracks and specifying conditions on the use of these days; changing certain requirements for days of racing at mile tracks; stating status of half-mile racing days when run at mile tracks; providing for annual grants to the Maryland State Fair and Baltimore County, subject to certain conditions and limitations; changing the requirements for distribution revenues; authorizing the Maryland State Fair to racing conduct Sunday racing under certain conditions; language; making necessary corrections; obsolete specifying the details of transfer of certain racing days in the State; and relating generally to half-mile racing days and the distribution of certain revenues.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 78B - Racing Commission Section 7(c), 15(a), and 19(a)(3) and (d), and 28 Annotated Code of Maryland (1980 Replacement Volume and 1983 Supplement)

BY adding to

Article 78B - Racing Commission Section 7(f), 15(e), and 16(e) Annotated Code of Maryland (1980 Replacement Volume and 1983 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 78B - Racing Commission

7.

(c) The Commission shall have the power to reject any application for a license for any cause which it may deem sufficient and the action of the Commission shall be final. No one person, corporation or association shall be given a license to conduct racing for more than ninety (90) days in one year, nor shall more than an aggregate of one hundred and twenty (120) days
