

group, organization or corporation personally and such permit shall not be transferable.

(6) Only those bona fide religious, fraternal, civic, veterans' hospital, amateur athletic or charitable organizations or corporations shall be eligible for a permit which spend the greater part of their funds for fraternal, civic, veterans' hospital, amateur athletic or charitable purposes in Baltimore City, if the raffle, carnival, or bazaar is to be held there[, or in Baltimore County, if to be held there].

(b) (1) Before the police commissioner of Baltimore City [or the chief of police of Baltimore County, as the case may be,] shall issue a permit for any such carnival, bazaar or raffle, it shall be his duty to ascertain the character of the organization on whose behalf the application is made to determine if such application comes within the provisions of this section.

(2) The application and the action taken thereon by the police commissioner of Baltimore City [or the chief of police of Baltimore County, as the case may be,] shall be a public record.

(c) Any person, association, or corporation knowingly operating or attempting to operate a bazaar or raffle as authorized by this section in violation thereof, shall upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine not exceeding [one thousand dollars (\$1,000)] \$1,000 or imprisoned for not more than [one] 1 year, or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.

SECTION 2- 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.

CHAPTER 512

(Senate Bill 63)

AN ACT concerning

Carroll County - Alcoholic Beverages - Maryland Wine Festival

FOR the purpose of providing for the establishment of a Maryland Wine Festival in Carroll County; creating a special alcoholic beverages license for the Festival; limiting the license to the sale and display of wine that is ~~bottled~~ fermented produced and processed in Maryland; providing for the qualifications of an applicant and the scope of the license; providing a time period for the festival; mandating
