(Senate Bill 256)

AN ACT concerning

Legal Services Corporation - Abandoned-Property Funding

FOR ~~the purpose of requiring the Governor, with the approval of the Board of Public Works, to annually transfer from the abandoned property special fund a certain amount for payment to the Maryland Legal Services Corporation to support the activities of the Corporation.~~ requiring the Governor to annually appropriate a certain amount in the State budget to support certain costs of the Maryland Legal Services Corporation; authorizing an annual transfer of certain abandoned property funds; repealing obsolete language; and generally relating to the funding of the Maryland Legal Services Corporation.
