- (II) IN BALTIMORE CITY, BY THE MAYOR WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE CITY COUNCIL; OR
- (III) IN ANY COUNTY THAT HAS A COUNTY EXECUTIVE, BY THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL.
  - (2) OF THE 9 MEMBERS:
- (I) 1 SHALL BE A PROFESSIONAL REPRESENTATIVE OF THE LOCAL DEPARTMENT;
- (II) 2 SHALL BE PHYSICIANS, INCLUDING 1 PSYCHIATRIST FROM THE LOCAL DEPARTMENTS OF HEALTH THAT EMPLOY PSYCHIATRISTS;
- (III) 1 SHALL BE A REPRESENTATIVE OF A LOCAL COMMISSION ON AGING;
- (IV) 1 SHALL BE A PROFESSIONAL REPRESENTATIVE OF A LOCAL NONPROFIT SOCIAL SERVICE ORGANIZATION;
  - (V) 1 SHALL BE A LAWYER;
  - (VI) 2 SHALL BE LAY INDIVIDUALS; AND
  - (VII) 1 SHALL BE A PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE.
  - (B) (1) THE TERM OF A MEMBER IS 3 YEARS.
- (2) THE TERMS OF MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE REVIEW BOARD ON OCTOBER 1, 1984.
- (3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- (4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

14-403.

- (A) A MEMBER OF THE REVIEW BOARD:
  - (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION; BUT
- (2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
- (B) THE LOCAL DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE THE OFFICE SPACE AND PERSONNEL THAT THE REVIEW BOARD NEEDS TO PERFORM ITS DUTIES.
