To apply for certification, an applicant shall:

- (1) Submit an application to the Board on the form that the Board requires; and
 - (2) Pay to the Board an application fee [of:
- (i) \$10 for certification as a sanitarian in training;
- (ii) \$15 for certification as a registered sanitarian, if at the time of application the applicant is a sanitarian in training; or
- (iii) \$25 for certification as a registered sanitarian, if the applicant is not a sanitarian in training] TO COVER THE ACTUAL COST OF EXAMINATIONS AND THE ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES.

- (a) An applicant who otherwise qualifies for certification is entitled to be examined as provided in this section and [§§ 17-302, 17-303, and 17-306] § 5.5-302 of this subtitle.
- (b) The Board shall give examinations to applicants at least once a year, at the times and places that the Board determines.
- (c) The Board shall notify each qualified applicant of the time and place of examination.
- (d) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, the Board shall determine the subjects, scope, form, and passing score for examinations given under this subtitle.
