(2) THE PROGRAM SHALL ASSIST IN PROVIDING FAMILY SUPPORT SERVICES THAT ARE NOT OTHERWISE AVAILABLE.

(A) FOR THE PERIOD JULY 1, 1984 THROUGH JUNE 30, 1985 FOR THE PROGRAM, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL USE A GRANT FROM THE MARYLAND STATE PLANNING COUNCIL ON DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES NOT TO EXCEED \$210,000.

(B) BEGINNING JULY 1, 1985 THROUGH JUNE 30, 1986, THE DEPARTMENT ~~SHALL--PROVIDE-50-PERCENT-OF-THE,~~ TO THE EXTENT FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE, SHALL REQUEST FUNDING FOR THE PROGRAM NOT TO EXCEED \$110,000 AND SHALL USE A GRANT FROM THE MARYLAND STATE PLANNING COUNCIL ON DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES NOT TO EXCEED \$110,000.

(C) BEGINNING JULY 1, 1986 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUEST, TO THE EXTENT FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE, BUDGET SUPPORT THAT IS SUFFICIENT TO OPERATE THE PROGRAM AND SHALL CONTINUE TO PROVIDE FAMILY SUPPORT SERVICES AT LEAST FOR THE LEVEL IN EFFECT ON JUNE 30, 1986.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.
