(c) Any shelter established under this section shall be subject to the following conditions:

(2) The [Social Services Administration] DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES shall:

(i) supervise the shelter;

(ii) set standards of care and admission policies;

(iii) monitor the operation of the shelter and annually evaluate the effectiveness of the shelter; and

(iv) adopt rules and regulations that set fees for services at and govern the operation of each shelter;

CHAPTER 623

(House Bill 500)

AN ACT concerning

Podiatry - Waiver of Examinations
