CHAPTER 632

(House Bill 565)

AN ACT concerning

Frederick County - Alcoholic Beverages

FOR the purpose of permitting the Frederick County License Commissioner to impose certain penalties for violations of certain alcoholic beverages laws in Frederick County; providing that the proceeds from these fines shall be deposited into the general funds of Frederick County; and generally relating to Frederick County alcoholic beverages laws.

BY adding to

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages Section 203(q) Annotated Code of Maryland (1981 Replacement Volume and 1983 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

203.

(Q) IN FREDERICK COUNTY, THE LICENSE COMMISSIONER MAY IMPOSE A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,500 PER OFFENSE OR SUSPEND AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE FOR ANY VIOLATION THAT IS CAUSE FOR SUSPENSION UNDER THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LAWS AFFECTING FREDERICK COUNTY. THE COMMISSIONER MAY BOTH SUSPEND AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE AND IMPOSE THE FINE ON A LICENSEE FOR THESE VIOLATIONS. ALL MONEYS COLLECTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE GENERAL FUNDS OF FREDERICK COUNTY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.
