- (ii) An operating landfill that, under \S 7-232(b) of this subtitle, has a permit equivalent to a facility permit.
- (j) "Facility permit" means a permit issued by the Department to establish, operate, or maintain a controlled hazardous substance facility.

7-240.

The Department may deny an application for a facility permit if the Department finds that:

- (1) [the] THE controlled hazardous substance facility cannot handle, treat, store, or dispose of a particular controlled hazardous substance without imposing an undue risk to the environment; OR
- (2) THE OWNER OF THE LAND ON--WHICH--THE--CONTROLLED HAZARDOUS--SUBSTANCE-FACILITY--IS--PLANNED--TO-BE-LOCATED-OR-ANY OWNER,--OFFICER,--OPERATOR,--OR--PRINCIPAL-OF---THE---CONTROLLED HAZARDOUS-SUBSTANCE-FACILITY OR ANY PERSON MAKING APPLICATION HAS VIOLATED:
- (1) ANY LAW OF THIS OR ANY OTHER STATE CONCERNING CONTROLLED HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES; OR
- (II) ANY RULE OR REGULATION OF-THE-DEPARTMENT OR PERMIT CONDITION OF THIS OR ANY OTHER STATE CONCERNING CONTROLLED HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.
