an equal and matching fund of \$100,000. No part of applicant's matching fund may be provided, either directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated No part of the fund may consist of real unappropriated. property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter, and the Board's decision final. The Maryland Hall for the Creative Arts, Inc. has is until June 1, 1986, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that the matching fund will be provided. satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact to the State Treasurer and the proceeds of the loan shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. If this evidence is not presented by June 1, 1986, the proceeds of the loan shall applied to the purposes authorized in Article 78A, § 3 of the Code.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1984.

CHAPTER 654

(House Bill 847)

AN ACT concerning

Montgomery County Housing Opportunities Commission - Bonds MC 440-84
