1-102.

THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE COUNCIL SHALL CONSIST OF:

(1)--5-MEMBERS-APPOINTED-BY-THE-GOVERNORS-OF-DELAWARE-MARYLAND, - AND-VIRGINIA,

- (1) 15 MEMBERS, 5 APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR OF MARYLAND, 5 BY THE GOVERNOR OF DELAWARE, AND 5 BY THE GOVERNOR OF VIRGINIA;
- (2) WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE 3 GOVERNORS, SUCH OTHER MEMBERS FROM COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENTS AND THE PRIVATE SECTOR AS MAY BE ESTABLISHED FROM TIME TO TIME IN THE BYLAWS OF THE COUNCIL.

1-103.

COUNCIL MEMBERS SHALL ANNUALLY ELECT A CHAIRMAN AND SUCH OTHER OFFICERS AS MAY BE DEEMED NECESSARY.

1-104.

MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL SHALL SERVE WITHOUT PAY EXCEPT THAT THEY SHALL MAY BE REIMBURSED FOR ACTUAL EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THEIR DUTIES.

1-105.

THE COUNCIL SHALL HOLD QUARTERLY MEETINGS AT A TIME AND PLACE DESIGNATED BY THE COUNCIL AND SHALL HOLD ADDITIONAL MEETINGS AS DEEMED NECESSARY.

1-106.

THE COUNCIL SHALL HOLD NOT LESS THAN 1 MEETING EACH YEAR AT WHICH THE PUBLIC IS GIVEN AN OPPORTUNITY TO EXPRESS VIEWS CONCERNING REGIONAL ISSUES.

1-107.

THE COUNCIL MAY ADOPT BYLAWS, RULES, AND REGULATIONS FOR ITS GOVERNING AND OPERATION NOT INCONSISTENT WITH THIS LEGISLATION OR LAWS OF THE STATES OF DELAWARE, MARYLAND, AND VIRGINIA.

1-108.

THE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE COUNCIL SHALL INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED, TO THE FOLLOWING:

- (1) ASSIST IN THE IDENTIFICATION OF PERCEIVED REGIONAL PROBLEMS AND ISSUES;
- (2) ASSIST TO DEVELOP EFFECTIVE SOLUTIONS FOR SUCH PROBLEMS AND ISSUES:
