(III) BE PAID FOR BY THE APPLICANT THROUGH A FILING FEE, A SUBSEQUENT ASSESSMENT, OR BOTH, UNLESS COVERED BY THE INITIAL FILING FEE PAID BY THE APPLICANT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.
