- (1) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE, A MEMBER WHO IS IN SERVICE ON JULY 1, 1984 MAY ELECT TO RECEIVE A RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.
- (2) (A) A MEMBER IN SERVICE ON JULY 1, 1984 WHO WISHES TO SELECT THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION SHALL NOTIFY THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM NOT LATER THAN 0CF0BER-1, 1984 JANUARY 1, 1985 OF THIS ACTION ON FORMS PROVIDED BY THE SYSTEM. A MEMBER NOT IN SERVICE ON JULY 1, 1984 BUT WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO RETURN TO SERVICE IN THE SYSTEM SHALL HAVE 90 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF RETURN TO SERVICE TO SELECT THE OPTION PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.
- (3) A MEMBER WHO SELECTS THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION SHALL RECEIVE A RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE FOR ALL CREDITABLE SERVICE AS FOLLOWS:
- (A) FOR SERVICE RETIREMENT AS PROVIDED BY § 86(2)(A) OF THIS ARTICLE;
- (B) FOR EARLY RETIREMENT FOR SERVICE AS PROVIDED BY § 86(2)(B) OF THIS ARTICLE;
- (C) FOR RETIREMENT FOR ORDINARY DISABILITY AS PROVIDED BY § 86(4) OF THIS ARTICLE; AND
- (D) FOR RETIREMENT FOR ACCIDENTAL DISABILITY AS PROVIDED BY § 86(4B) OF THIS ARTICLE.
- (4) A MEMBER WHO SELECTS THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION SHALL HAVE THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE ADJUSTED AS PROVIDED IN § 86A OF THIS ARTICLE.
- (5) FOR CREDITABLE SERVICE FROM JULY 1, 1984, THE PROPORTION OF EARNABLE COMPENSATION PAYABLE AS PROVIDED BY § 89(1)(A) OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE INCREASED BY AN ADDITIONAL 2 PERCENT OF EARNABLE COMPENSATION.
