

(2) Room and board of a recipient who lives off-campus shall be paid on vouchers approved by the institution.

(H) THE STATE SCHOLARSHIP BOARD:

(1) MAY ACCEPT ANY GIFT OR GRANT FROM ANY PERSON FOR THE EDWARD T. CONROY SCHOLARSHIP FUND;

(2) SHALL USE ANY GIFT OR GRANT THAT IT RECEIVES FOR THE PROGRAM FOR AID TO A NEEDY STUDENT WHO IS THE RECIPIENT OF A SCHOLARSHIP FROM THE PROGRAM; AND

(3) SHALL DEPOSIT ANY GIFT OR GRANT THAT IT RECEIVES FOR THE PROGRAM WITH THE STATE TREASURER IN A NONBUDGETED ACCOUNT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.

CHAPTER 696

(House Bill 1410)

AN ACT concerning

Use of School Property - Charges

FOR the purpose of providing that those who use public school facilities for ~~community--purposes-may-be-charged-a-rental~~ fee commercial use may be charged for rent and recovery of capital costs.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

7-110.

(a) (1) A reasonable charge for RENTAL, heating, lighting, and janitorial services for use of public school facilities under §§ 7-108 and 7-109 of this subtitle may be made.
