SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 25 - County Commissioners

3.

(a) (1) The county commissioners of each county in this State, in addition to, but not in substitution of, the powers which have been or may be granted them, have the following express powers.

(2) (i) The following counties are excepted from these express powers.

(ii) Anne Arundel County,

(iii) Baltimore County,

(iv) Cecil County; included, however, in [subsection] SUBSECTIONS (L) AND (s-1),

(v) Howard County,

(vi) Prince George's County,

(vii) Queen Anne's County; included, however, in subsections (f), (s)(3), (s-1), and (ii),

(viii) Worcester County; included, however, in subsections (1), (s)(2), (x), (x-1), (x-2), and (y).

(1) (1) To provide for competitive bidding for any county work and the making and awarding of contracts for the purchase of materials and supplies in excess of \$500 and to require bonds in
