SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 74 - Pilots

The Board of Examiners of Pilots is a body politic and corporate, and may appoint a register who shall enter in a book to be provided for that purpose all applications to and all other proceedings of the said Board and shall countersign all warrants for pilots granted by the Board.]

[The Board of Examiners of Maryland Pilots is hereby created and shall be a part of the Department of Licensing and Regulation. It shall consist of a designee of the Secretary of Transportation, the president of the Baltimore Chamber of Commerce, the president of the Association of Maryland Pilots and four members appointed by the Governor, with the advice of the Secretary of Licensing and Regulation.
