

Commercial District Management Authority

FOR the purpose of authorizing municipal corporations, county commissioners, chartered counties, and code counties to create commercial district management authorities, to specify their membership, organization, jurisdiction, geographical limits, purposes, functions and powers-7; to provide financing for the authorities and their activities, and to create the authorities as special tax districts with the power to levy; designating certain uses for taxes or fees collected; providing certain limitations on the powers of commercial district management authorities; authorizing municipal corporations to establish special taxing districts in support of business and commerce; and generally relating to commercial district management authorities.
