- (C) (1) COMPUTATION OF THE TOTAL TAKEOUT AND BREAKAGE FOR WAGERING MADE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE THE SAME AS THAT NORMALLY APPLICABLE TO RACING CONDUCTED BY THE LICENSEE.
- THE REMAINDER SHALL BE ALLOCATED 50% TO THE LICENSEE AND 50% TO PURSES. THE PENSION FUND ALLOCATION SHALL BE DEDUCTED FROM THE SHARE OF THE LICENSEE, AND THE BRED FUND ALLOCATION SHALL BE DEDUCTED FROM THE DEDUCTED FROM THE SHARE FOR PURSES.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Racing Commission shall present a report to the Legislative Policy Committee within 30 days of implementing the telephone betting system detailing the procedures for the operation and oversight of the system.

SECTION -2- $\underline{3}$. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect January 1, 1985.

(House Bill 15)

Video Movie Sales and Rentals - Ratings

FOR the purpose of requiring certain ratings to be displayed on the outside of a cassette, case, jacket, or other covering of certain video movies; providing a penalty for violations; and generally relating to video movie rentals and sales.
