- (a) A Class A beer, wine and liquor license shall be issued by the clerk of the circuit court of the county in which the place of business is located, and shall authorize the holder to keep for sale and to sell all alcoholic beverages at retail, in any quantity, at the place therein described, and to deliver the same in a sealed package or container which package or container may not be opened nor its contents consumed on the premises where sold. The annual fee for this license is \$500, except as otherwise provided in this section, and in all cases the fee shall be payable to the clerk before any such license is issued, for distribution as hereinafter provided.
 - (o) (1) In Harford County the annual license fee is:
- (i) 7 day license \$1,250 Class A-1 off-sale beer, wine and liquor license.
- (ii) 6 day license (Monday through Saturday) \$800 Class A-2 off-sale beer, wine and liquor license.

- (4) ANY LICENSEE WHO HOLDS A CLASS B BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE UNDER SECTION 19(N)(1) OR (4) OF THIS ARTICLE OR A CLASS B BEER AND WINE LICENSE UNDER SECTION 14(G), AND WHO HAS BEEN GRANTED AN OPTION TO THE EXISTING LICENSE THAT ALLOWS FOR OFF-SALE LIQUOR IS SUBJECT TO SECTION 19(N)(6) OF THIS ARTICLE.
