

THE COMPTROLLER OF THE TREASURY IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF FUNDS IN THE ENERGY ASSISTANCE AND WEATHERIZATION TRUST FUND, AND SHALL MAKE AN ANNUAL REPORT TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES, TO THE GOVERNOR, AND, SUBJECT TO § 2-1212 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLES, TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY CONCERNING THE MANAGEMENT OF THE FUNDS IN THE PRECEDING YEAR.

(A) (1) THERE IS A BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE ENERGY ASSISTANCE AND WEATHERIZATION TRUST FUND CONSISTING OF 9 MEMBERS.

(2) OF THE 9 MEMBERS-

(1) THE 5 VOTING MEMBERS SHALL BE-

1. THE COMPTROLLER OF THE TREASURY,
2. THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES,
3. THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES, AND
4. 2 MEMBERS FROM THE PUBLIC APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR, AND

(11) THE 4 NONVOTING EX-OFFICIO MEMBERS SHALL BE-

1. THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENTAL MATTERS OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES,
2. THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE ON APPROPRIATIONS OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES,
3. THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE ON ECONOMIC AFFAIRS OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND, AND
4. THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE ON BUDGET AND TAXATION OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND.

(B) (1) THE TERM OF A BOARD MEMBER FROM THE PUBLIC IS 2 YEARS.

(2) AT THE END OF A TERM, A BOARD MEMBER FROM THE PUBLIC CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(3) A BOARD MEMBER FROM THE PUBLIC WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(4) A BOARD MEMBER FROM THE PUBLIC MAY SERVE SUCCESSIVE TERMS.
