30.01.04.02 Wildlife Management

In addition to the appropriation shown on page 47 of the printed bill, to provide for an accelerated waterfowl habitat restoration effort for the black duck and dabbling species and initial operating expenses for the proposed duck hatchery contingent upon enactment of legislation increasing the Migratory Waterfowl Stamp fee from \$3.00 to \$6.00.

The Department of Natural Resources may use the funds as allowed for propagation, purchase, and distribution of hand reared ducks, and waterfowl projects included in an approved State program to create, develop, maintain, manage, preserve, and enhance waterfowl/habitat on public lands. Funds which are designated for the operation of hatchery facilities shall be placed in a reserve account until such time as the hatchery is constructed.
