

In addition to the appropriation shown on page 51 of the printed bill, to initiate a study and planting effort to facilitate the reestablishment of submerged aquatic vegetation; implement a program for protection of non-tidal wetlands; maintain and enhance data management analysis activities; and carry out a monitoring effort of living resources and habitat. The Special Fund appropriation is contingent upon enactment of legislation authorizing a tidal fishing license.
