A House Joint Resolution concerning

Task Force for Voter Registration

FOR the purpose of requesting the Governor to establish a task force on voter registration to study and make recommendations for increasing voter registration and participation in the State; providing for the-membership, appointment,--and-staffing appointment and membership of the task force; providing that the task force submit reports to the Governor and the General Assembly annually,-beginning-on by a certain date; and generally relating to establishing a task force on voter registration.
