In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 601.

This bill provides that the Baltimore County Council may grant a county real property tax credit against county taxes levied on homes in certain homeowners' associations and generally relates to a Baltimore County real property tax credit.

House Bill 390, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 8, 1984, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 601.
