AN ACT concerning

Cecil County - Volunteer Length of Service Award Program

FOR the purpose of permitting the Cecil County Commissioners to establish and fund a Volunteer Length of Service Award Program for certain members of volunteer fire departments, rescue squads, and ambulance corps in Cecil County; providing certain service credits for persons subject to the provisions of this Act; providing that the County Commissioners, by resolution, may adopt bylaws for the Program; providing that certain specific provisions may be included in the bylaws; providing that certain administrative and recordkeeping responsibilities of the Program may be delegated by the County Commissioners; providing that the Program may be funded within certain restrictions from general revenue county funds or any other available source; and generally relating to the establishment of a Volunteer Length of Service Award Program in Cecil County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (A) IN CECIL COUNTY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY ESTABLISH AND FUND A VOLUNTEER LENGTH OF SERVICE AWARD PROGRAM FOR QUALIFIED MEMBERS OF VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENTS, RESCUE SQUADS, AND AMBULANCE CORPS.
- (B) THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, BY RESOLUTION, MAY ADOPT BYLAWS FOR A VOLUNTEER LENGTH OF SERVICE AWARD PROGRAM.
 - (C) IN THE BYLAWS, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY:
 - (1) DEFINE TERMS:
