- [(b) The term "commercial motor vehicle" means a passenger vehicle that has seats for more than 14 passengers in addition to the driver and for the operation of which a permit is required by the Public Service Commission, or any road tractor, or any truck-tractor or any truck having more than two axles, or any truck towing for a commercial purpose, a freight trailer or semitrailer as defined under § 13-927(c) of the Transportation Article; which commercial motor vehicle is propelled by motor fuel.]
- (B) THE TERM "COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE" MEANS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING VEHICLES THAT ARE PROPELLED BY MOTOR FUEL:
- (1) A PASSENGER VEHICLE THAT HAS SEATS FOR MORE THAN 14 PASSENGERS IN ADDITION TO THE DRIVER;
- (2) A TRUCK TRACTOR AS DEFINED IN § 11-172 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE;
