SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 3 - FISCAL YEAR 1985

March 26, 1984

Mr. President, Mr. Speaker, Ladies and Gentlemen
of the General Assembly:

Pursuant to the authority conferred on me by Article III, Section 52, Subsection (5) of the Constitution of Maryland, and in accordance with the consent of the (State Senate) - (House of Delegates), duly granted, I hereby submit a further supplement to Senate Bill 250 and/or House Bill 350 in the form of an amendment to the original budget and Supplemental Budgets for the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 1985.

The Supplemental Budget No. 3 will affect the previously estimated funds available for budget operations as shown on the following summary statement.
