Dear Mr. Speaker:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 754.

This bill increases from 30 to 60 the number of days within which the Regional Planning Council must approve or disapprove any plan or areawide development project proposal referred by any local government within the regional planning area.

Senate Bill 432, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 8, 1984, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 754.
