

(A) -- WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE RECEIPT OF A NOTICE OF A RECOMMENDED SUSPENSION, THE COMMITTEE SHALL CONDUCT A PUBLIC HEARING ON ALL OR PART OF THE REGULATION.

(B) -- WITHIN 5 DAYS AFTER THE HEARING THE COMMITTEE SHALL VOTE TO APPROVE OR SUSPEND ALL OR PART OF THE REGULATION.

(C) -- IF THE COMMITTEE FAILS TO MEET THE DEADLINES PROVIDED UNDER THIS SECTION, THE REGULATION SHALL BE CONSIDERED APPROVED.

(D) -- IF THE COMMITTEE SUSPENDS ANY REGULATION, OR ANY PORTION OF ANY REGULATION, THE REGULATION OR PORTION THAT WAS SUSPENDED MAY NOT TAKE EFFECT UNTIL JUNE 1, FOLLOWING THE NEXT SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

SECTION 2. -- AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1984.

Article 40 --- General Assembly

40B.

(A) -- IN ADDITION TO ITS AUTHORITY UNDER § 40A (C) WITH REGARD TO THE EMERGENCY ADOPTION OF REGULATIONS, THE COMMITTEE SHALL REVIEW ALL OTHER PROPOSED REGULATIONS AND MAY SUSPEND THE ADOPTION OF SUCH REGULATIONS UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

(B) -- DURING THE 45 DAY REVIEW PERIOD UNDER ARTICLE 41, § 256-1, THE COMMITTEE SHALL REVIEW THE PROPOSED REGULATION AND CONDUCT THE PROCEEDINGS IT CONSIDERS APPROPRIATE.

(C) -- IF THE COMMITTEE DETERMINES THAT AN APPROPRIATE REVIEW CANNOT REASONABLY BE CONDUCTED WITHIN 45 DAYS AND THAT AN ADDITIONAL PERIOD OF REVIEW IS REQUIRED, IT MAY DELAY THE ADOPTION OF THE REGULATION OR ANY PORTION THEREOF FOR AN ADDITIONAL PERIOD OF UP TO 30 DAYS BY 60 NOTIFYING THE PROMULGATING UNIT AND THE DIVISION OF STATE DOCUMENTS, IN WRITING, PRIOR TO THE EXPIRATION OF THE 45 DAY PERIOD.

(D) -- (1) -- DURING THE REVIEW PERIOD UNDER ARTICLE 41, § 256-1 AND ANY EXTENSION THEREOF UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, AND SUBJECT TO THE OTHER PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, THE COMMITTEE MAY ORDER THAT ADOPTION OF THE REGULATION OR ANY PORTION THEREOF BE SUSPENDED AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION IF THE COMMITTEE FINDS THE REGULATION OR THE SUSPENDED PORTION THEREOF:

(i) -- IS UNCONSTITUTIONAL;

(ii) -- EXCEEDS THE STATUTORY AUTHORITY OF THE PROMULGATING UNIT;
