- (a) Except for the fees specifically set by this title, the Board may set reasonable fees for the issuance and renewal of certificates and its other services.
- (b) The Board shall pay all funds collected under this title into the General Fund of this State.

Subtitle 3. Licensing

An individual shall be certified as a registered [sanitarian] ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH-PRACTITIONER SANITARIAN by the Board before the individual may:

- (1) Use the title "registered [sanitarian] ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH-PRACTITIONER SANITARIAN";
- (2) Use the initials $-\frac{1}{2}$ -"R.S."-}--"R-E-H-P-" after the name of the person; or
- (3) Represent to the public that the individual is a registered [sanitarian] ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH---PRACTITIONER SANITARIAN.

(a) To qualify for certification as a registered [sanitarian] ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH--PRACTITIONER SANITARIAN, an applicant shall be an individual who meets the requirements of this section.
