- (a) Except as provided in this section for an action under  $[\S 17-314]$   $\S 5.5-313$   $\underline{312}$  of this subtitle, any person aggrieved by a final decision of the Board in a contested case, as defined in the Administrative Procedure Act, may:
  - (1) Appeal that decision to the Board of Review; and
- (2) Then take any further appeal allowed by the Administrative Procedure Act.
- (b) (1) Any person aggrieved by a final decision of the Board under [§ 17-314] § 5.5-313 312 of this subtitle may not appeal to the Secretary or Board of Review but may take a direct judicial appeal.
- (2) The appeal shall be made as provided for judicial review of final decisions in the Administrative Procedure Act.

The Board, on the affirmative vote of a majority of its full authorized membership, may reinstate the certification of an individual whose certification has been revoked.

Subtitle 4. Prohibited Acts; Penalties

## [17-401.] 5.5-401.

- (a) Unless a person is certified as a registered [sanitarian] ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH-PRACTITIONER SANITARIAN under this title, the person may not represent to the public that the person is a registered [sanitarian] ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH PRACTITIONER SANITARIAN.
- (b) Unless a person is certified as a registered [sanitarian] ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH-PRACTITIONER SANITARIAN under this title, the person may not use the title "registered [sanitarian] ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH-PRACTITIONER SANITARIAN" or the initials -{-"R.S."-}--"R-E-H-P-" after the name of the person.

## [17-404.] 5.5-402.

A person who violates any provision of [§ 17-401] § 5.5-102 OR § 5.5-401 of this subtitle is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$100 or imprisonment not exceeding 60 days or both.
