THE COMMITTEE WILL REVIEW THAT ACTION FOR ITS APPROPRIATENESS AND MAY WAIVE COMPLIANCE WITH A RECOMMENDATION OF THE LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR IF THE UNIT OF STATE GOVERNMENT SATISFIES THE COMMITTEE THAT THE RECOMMENDATION GANNOT SHOULD NOT BE CARRIED OUT. A WAIVER SHALL BE REPORTED TO THE LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR WITH AN EXPLANATION AS TO WHY IT WAS GRANTED.
