RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ANNAPOLIS
TO AMEND THE CITY CHARTER BY REPEALING
AND RE-ENACTING CERTAIN SECTIONS THEREOF

A RESOLUTION of the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis, adopted pursuant to the authority of Article XI-E of the Constitution of the State of Maryland and Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland, to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 40 of the Charter of the City of Annapolis; for the purpose of providing that the Mayor and Aldermen may take certain actions in considering appeals from decisions of the Port Wardens; providing that appeals to the Mayor and Aldermen from decisions of the Port Warden shall be on the record made before the Port Wardens; and all matters generally related thereto.

AND TO ADOPT A NEW CHARTER IN LIEU THEREOF

A RESOLUTION of the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis, adopted pursuant to the authority of Article XI-E of the Constitution of the State of Maryland and Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland, to repeal the Charter of the City of Annapolis consisting of Sections 1 through 97 thereof, inclusive, and to adopt a new Charter for the municipal corporation known as the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis to stand in the place of the Charter so repealed; for the purpose of reestablishing a form of government for the municipal corporation known as the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis; providing for the continuation of existing boundaries of the municipal corporation, subject to future alterations; providing for the election and appointment of officials of the municipal corporation; specifying the powers of the municipal corporation; providing for operating departments of the municipal corporation and the duties and responsibilities of each; providing for the administration of personnel and retirement matters for the
