Charter Amendment

Resolution No. 84-R-01

Resolution of the Council of Landover Hills, Maryland, adopted pursuant to the authority of Article XI-E of the Constitution of the State of Maryland and Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 edition, as amended), title: "Corporation-Municipal," to repeal and reenact with amendments, the Charter of said Town of Landover Hills.

Whereas, the present Charter of Landover Hills was enacted on 28 June 1980, by the Town Council, and adopted in the Laws of Maryland, Chapter 465, 1945, as amended or replaced.

Whereas, this Charter serves as the basic instrument of government for the Town of Landover Hills;

Whereas, changes in the Town's needs require that the Charter be kept up to date in reflecting these changes;

Whereas, this document is not up to date in its present form and language in reflecting current Town needs;

Whereas, certain changes in the Charter have been proposed by the Landover Hills Council;
