A RESOLUTION to repeal Sections PC22, PC23, PC25, PC26, and PC28 of the Charter of the Town of Pittsville, and to re-enact with amendments Sections PC22, PC23, PC25, PC26, and PC28, and to add a new Section PC33, said sections providing that qualified voters must be registered with the Town of Pittsville; providing that those persons who are registered to vote in State and County elections on May 1, 1983 will be automatically transferred to the Election Books of the Town of Pittsville and that only those
