AN EMERGENCY ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments, Subsection (c), heading, Applications and Examinations, and Subsection (i), heading, Records and Reports, of Section 201A, heading, Classified Service, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Harford County, Maryland, as amended; to provide for the elimination of a requirement regarding applications for employment so the Office of Personnel may operate more efficiently; and to provide for a change in the reporting requirements for attendance records.
