(Senate Bill 44)

AN ACT concerning

Garrett and Somerset County Commissioners - Refuse Collection, Removal, and Disposal

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Garrett and Somerset County Commissioners to require, regulate, or provide for the collection, removal, and disposal of refuse and garbage; authorizing the Garrett and Somerset County Commissioners to license refuse collectors for hire; making it unlawful to collect, remove, or dispose of refuse for hire in Garrett County and Somerset County without a license; and authorizing the Garrett and Somerset County Commissioners to suspend, revoke, or renew licenses to collect, remove, or dispose of refuse.
