- (b) Licenses for the sale of alcoholic beverages of any class may not be transferred into the areas of Baltimore City covered by this section.
- (c) The prohibitions in this section do not apply to special 1-day licenses or to Class B beer, wine and liquor restaurant licenses to bona fide restaurants having:
- (1) A minimum capital investment of \$150,000 for restaurant facilities, not including the cost of land and building; and
  - (2) A minimum seating capacity of 75 persons.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.

## CHAPTER 106

(Senate Bill 261)

AN ACT concerning

Washington County - Traders! Issuance of Licenses

FOR the purpose of requiring Washington County officials to consider only the fiscal year during which a trader's license is issued in determining whether there are any unpaid taxes.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 56 - Licenses Section 2A(a) Annotated Code of Maryland (1983 Replacement Volume)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article 56 - Licenses

2A.

(a) (1) A license provided for in this article shall not be issued by a clerk of court unless there is presented to him at the time of application, a receipt or certificate that contains the certification of the supervisor of assessments in the county
