or in Baltimore City showing the values of the merchandise, fixtures, and stock in trade for the business for which the license is applied, for the calendar year next preceding that for which the license is applied. The receipt or certificate also shall contain the certification of the county treasurer, or, in Baltimore City and in Montgomery County, the director of finance, and the certification of any municipal corporation in which the business is located that there are no unpaid taxes on the merchandise, fixtures, and stock due to the municipal corporation, to the county, or to the State.

(2) IN WASHINGTON COUNTY, THE TIME PERIOD FOR UNPAID TAXES PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION IS THE FISCAL YEAR THAT INCLUDES MAY 1 OF THE CALENDAR YEAR DURING WHICH THE LICENSE ACTUALLY IS ISSUED.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.

AN ACT concerning

Circuit Court Judges

FOR the purpose of altering the number of circuit court judges in Baltimore County, Frederick County, and Prince George's County.

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings Section 1-503 Annotated Code of Maryland (1980 Replacement Volume and 1983 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

1-503.

(a) In each county in the first seven judicial circuits there shall be the number of resident judges of the circuit court set forth below, including the judge or judges provided for by the Constitution:
