

(3) Sales of State Use Industries goods or services to any person, firm, or corporation for purposes of national defense when not prohibited by the acts of Congress; [or]

(4) Surplus goods from State Use Industries which remain after meeting the forecasted requirements of State agencies and political subdivisions if remaining unsold after 2 years; OR

(5) SALES OF STATE USE INDUSTRIES GOODS AND SERVICES FOR USE BY A CONTRACTOR OR SUBCONTRACTOR IN PERFORMANCE OF A CONTRACT WITH A STATE AGENCY OR WITH ANY OTHER GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY IN THIS STATE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.

AN ACT concerning

Election Code - Certification of Candidates

FOR the purpose of providing a time by which the State Administrative Board of Election Laws shall certify candidates for certain elections.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 33 - Election Code
