

(a) (1) If a petition OR CITATION is filed in a county other than the county where the child is living or domiciled, the court on its own motion or on motion of a party, may transfer the proceedings to the county of residence or domicile at any time prior to final termination of jurisdiction, except that the proceedings may not be transferred until after an adjudicatory hearing if the allegation is escape or attempted escape from a training school or similar facility operated by the Juvenile Services Administration.

(2) In its discretion, the court to which the case is transferred may take further action.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.

CHAPTER 166

(House Bill 173)

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore County - Property Tax Credits - Condominiums

FOR the purpose of permitting the Baltimore County Council to grant a credit against Baltimore County property taxes to certain condominium units under certain circumstances.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
