that election district. It authorizes the holder to keep for sale and to sell light wines produced at the winery in any quantity to any consumer at retail at the place described in the license. In Montgomery County, the holder's on-premises sales are limited to 20,000 gallons per year. The light wine shall be delivered in a sealed package or container which may not be opened or the contents consumed on the licensed premises.

- (b) The annual fee for this license is \$50.
- (c) This license may be issued in:
 - (1) Baltimore County,
 - (2) Carroll County,
 - (3) Frederick County,
 - (4) HARFORD COUNTY,
 - [(4)] (5) Montgomery County, and
- [(5)] (6) Washington County, but this license does not permit sales of wine on Sundays in such county.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.

CHAPTER 168

(House Bill 219)

AN ACT concerning

State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners - Appeals
