SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 41 - Governor - Executive and Administrative Departments

204E-2.

- (a) There is a citizens' advisory committee for the institutions of the Department located OR PLANNED FOR LOCATION in:
 - (1) Baltimore;
 - (2) Hagerstown; [and]
 - (3) Jessup; AND
 - (4) SOMERSET COUNTY.
- (b) Each committee consists of 7 members appointed by the Governor as required under subsections (c) and (d) of this section.
- (c) (1) The Senator and each Delegate from the legislative district in which the institutions are located shall each submit a name to the Governor.
- (2) (I) [Each] EXCEPT IN SOMERSET COUNTY, EACH member nominated by a Senator or Delegate shall be a resident of this State and of the legislative district in which the institutions are located.
- (II) IN SOMERSET COUNTY, EACH MEMBER NOMINATED BY A SENATOR OR DELEGATE SHALL BE A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE AND OF SOMERSET COUNTY.
- (3) The Governor shall appoint each person nominated by a Senator or Delegate for a vacancy on a committee within 60 days after receipt of the nominee's name.
- (d) (1) To the extent possible, the additional 3 members shall be appointed to provide for legal, law enforcement, and business representatives on each committee.
