FOR the purpose of altering the number of District Court judges in District 1 (Baltimore City) and District 5 (Prince George's County).

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

1-603.

(b) In each of the districts provided for in § 1-602 of this subtitle, there shall be the following number of associate judges of the District Court:

- (1) District 1--[22] 23
- (2) District 2--4
- (3) District 3--6, two to be appointed from Cecil County.
- (4) District 4--3
- (5) District 5--[9] 10
- (6) District 6--10
