## CHAPTER 197

## (House Bill 501)

AN ACT concerning

Maryland Agricultural Fair Board - Terms of Office

FOR the purpose of altering the term of office for members of the Maryland Agricultural Fair Board; providing that a member of the Board may not serve more than a certain number of consecutive terms; and making stylistic changes.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Agriculture Section 10-301(c) Annotated Code of Maryland (1974 Volume and 1983 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Agriculture

10-301.

- (c) (1) The term of office of each member is [three] 5 years, but any member appointed to fill a vacancy in an unexpired term serves for the remainder of the term.
- (2) Each member shall serve after expiration of [his] THE MEMBER'S term until  $\{his\}$  A successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (3) HOWEVER, A MEMBER MAY NOT SERVE MORE THAN 2 CONSECUTIVE 5-YEAR TERMS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That current members of the Maryland Agricultural Fair Board who have served 10 years or more may not be eligible for reappointment.

SECTION -2-  $\underline{3}$ . AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.
