CHAPTER 201

(House Bill 521)

AN ACT concerning

Nurses - Renewal Fee

FOR the purpose of providing that a renewal fee for a nurse's license may not exceed a certain amount if the nurse certifies to the Board of Examiners of Nurses that the nurse provides professional services only as a volunteer to a voluntary nonprofit organization; and providing that a volunteer's license be designated as a volunteer's license.
