(c) Before a license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an additional term, if the licensee:

(1) Otherwise is entitled to be licensed;

(2) Pays to the Board [a]:

(I) A renewal fee of \$20; [and] OR

(II) A RENEWAL FEE OF NOT MORE THAN \$2 THAT IS SET BY THE BOARD IF THE LICENSEE CERTIFIES TO THE BOARD THAT THE LICENSEE PROVIDES PROFESSIONAL SERVICES ONLY AS A VOLUNTEER TO A VOLUNTARY NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION; AND

(3) Submits to the Board a renewal application on the form that the Board requires.

(d) (1) The board shall renew the license of each licensee who meets the requirements of this section.

(2) A VOLUNTEER'S LICENSE ISSUED UNDER PARAGRAPH (C)(2)(II) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE CLEARLY DESIGNATED AS A VOLUNTEER'S LICENSE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.
