- (c) Before a license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an additional term, if the licensee:
 - (1) Otherwise is entitled to be licensed;
 - (2) Pays to the Board [a]:
 - (I) A renewal fee of \$20; [and] OR
- (II) A RENEWAL FEE OF NOT MORE THAN \$2 THAT IS SET BY THE BOARD IF THE LICENSEE CERTIFIES TO THE BOARD THAT THE LICENSEE PROVIDES PROFESSIONAL SERVICES ONLY AS A VOLUNTEER TO A VOLUNTARY NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION; AND
- (3) Submits to the Board a renewal application on the form that the Board requires.
- (d) (1) The board shall renew the license of each licensee who meets the requirements of this section.
- (2) A VOLUNTEER'S LICENSE ISSUED UNDER PARAGRAPH (C)(2)(II) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE CLEARLY DESIGNATED AS A VOLUNTEER'S LICENSE.
